### FACT SHEET

#### Description

Ishasha Jungle Lodges is operated under Uganda Jungle Lodges. It is built with robust canvas and stone pillars, simple yet elegant, furnished in contemporary safari style. The Lodge has six cottages offering 2 beds en-suite with bathroom with shower facility. All cottages face the savannah and river Ntungwe baya perfect setting to relax, read a book or gaze into the sky

Arrival area is deliberately set aside from the tents in order to maintain the tranquility of the camp. The cottages are widely spaced to ensure privacy and offer you a real sense of freedom. Every tent is surrounded by a diverse range of plant life and has fine views of the surrounding terrain.

#### Location

Ishasha Jungle Lodge is located 2km off Kitokye Gate of Queen Elizabeth National Park along River Ntungwe. This is the perfect location for your photographic safaris in the Ishasha sector of Queen Elizabeth National park and a stopover on the way to Bwindi National Park. The lodge is surrounded by riparian forest vegetation and acacias savannah.

#### Eco-lodge

Ishasha Jungle lodge uses clean energy and power. Solar systems give 24hr power and hot water to all cottages. All bulbs are of low energy consumption. Solar fridge provides safe storage and cold drinks. Cooking is provided with clean sources like gas and alternative charcoal. Attention is given to waste management disposal and recycling of any materials. Water is safe as it comes from a borehole. The Lodge does not offer facilities for disabled and infants.

#### Safety and food preparation

The Lodge management takes great care in safety measures in food preparations by checking quality of ingredients used in food preparation. We select ingredients and purchase food with attention to fresh organic foods. Our garden provides a variety of organic vegetables. We cater to all dietary needs of our guests.

#### Bar

Ensure plenty and variety of the fine wines, spirits and cool beer.

#### Access

The Lodge can be easily accessed by road coming in from Kampala or any other town in western Uganda through KIHIMI. Daily scheduled flights can be booked from Entebbe Airport to KIHIMI airstrip. Advanced booking required. Kihimi airstrip to Ishasha Jungle Lodge is 15 minutes drive.

#### Transfers

We offer transfers to and from kihimi airstrip, kihimi and Kitokye area. Nature drives are available on a safari vehicle for optimum game viewing and maximum photographic purposes.



### Internet and mobile services

We have internet from January 2016 and mobile network is available.

-The lodge offers specific accommodation for driver –guides at a minimum cost.

#### Lodge and conservation

The motto of the lodge is “Home of lions”, in consideration of the importance of the lions in this habitat, but especially in consideration of the great threats lions face in Queen Elizabeth National Park. Ishasha Jungle Lodge would like to contribute to bring awareness about the importance of the conservation of lions.

### Activities:

**KAMEME VILLAGE WALK** :This is a 2 hrs walk which starts from our lodge and takes you through the riparian forest along river Ntungwe and some cultivated farm to Kameme village where you will watch some birds and view crops like rice, coffee and maize. You will visit Kameme primary parent's school, a private school supported by the Association of parent / children. You will interact with pupils and teachers and share your experience with them. You will proceed to see some typical homesteads and interact with the villagers. You will see how bricks are made at the brick making sight. Visit also the local bar where local gin is served ( Uganda waragi) and see how it is made.
